



Parking...I Should know As a Member, I nor my visitors should not be parking in other Members numbered parking space. Members must take responsibility of your guests complying with RP's Rules and Regulations while visiting.

Vehicle Parking... I Should know All vehicles owned by or in possession of Members or their families must be registered at the RP Office. When a vehicle is sold or exchanged, it is the member's responsibility to file a new registration permit with the office. NO HOUSEHOLD CAN OCCUPY MORE THAN ONE (1) GUEST PARKING SPACE. HOUSEHOLDS WITH MORE THAN TWO (2) VEHICLES MAY OCCUPY THEIR ASSIGNED PARKING SPACE AND ONE (1) GUEST PARKING SPACE.

Vehicle Parking...I Should know there's NO MORE THAN 2 VEHICLES PER HOUSE-HOLD ALLOWED TO PARK ON RP PROPERTY. All/any additional vehicles must park along the north side of E. 40th Terr. or other auxiliary parking.

Pets...Having a pet at RP is not a "Right" but a Privilege. It is the Owner's responsibility to Clean up after their pet, the pet is not going to do it. If we see you walking your pet with no waste bags, clearly your not picking up its waste. Absolutely no pet should be allowed out of the townhouse without being restrained by a leash. THERE IS A ONE PET PER HOUSEHOLD LIMIT.

Complaints...I Should know Any complaint must be submitted in writing to the office in order for a complaint to be addressed.

Ownership...I Should know what I exactly own as a member of a Cooperative... A Cooperative member owns a Membership or a share of stock in the corporation. they do not own their unit (the structure or the area around it).

Lock-Outs...I Should know Lock-outs during office hours are \$5.00 and after hour lock-outs are \$30.00.

Carrying Charges... I Should know that Carrying charges (not rent) is the term we use since we are not a rental property. I know carrying charges are due on the 1st and late after the 10th. I know I owe \$100 if I'm late.

This is a Housing Cooperative I Should know this.





What Happens When I Move?

Here's a reminder...

You do need to call the office and set an appointment to sign your Intent To Vacate. This gives River Park the right to put your membership on the market for sale. You are required to bring in your Move-In

packet at that time. This includes your Membership Certificate, Brochures and your Occupancy Agreement. You will be responsible for the monthly carrying charges and utilities until an applicant is approved and moves

into your unit. Also, the responsibility of the selling member is having the unit rehabilitated and brought back to standard as it was done For additional information, for you when you moved in. If you can find your own buyer

it is to your benefit. You may want to remain in your unit until a buyer can be approved.
