Charge was won by Jojuana McLemore.

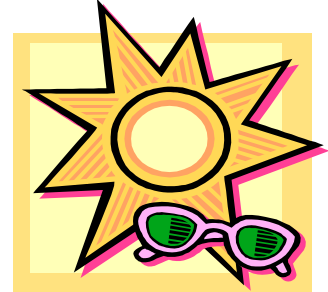


The winner of the Second Prize of \$50.00 was won by Lillian Watson.

Help keep your home in good repair. When using your shower always turn on the vent fan to prevent ceilings from peeling.

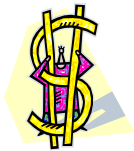
*Courtesy goes both ways, be careful when driving, watch for children on bikes.*
