The third Prize winner of \$25.00 was won by Darryl & Yolanda Williams.

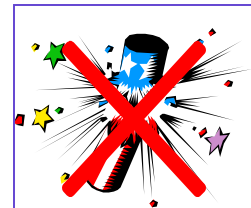
Several other prizes of flowers were drawn for.

A financial Report was presented by Lisa Gamble, Linville Management Services, Inc. She discussed how our money is put to use.

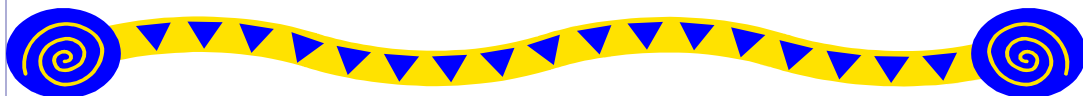

## Back to School Sales Tax Holiday, August 7-9th



Missouri's 2009 Tax Free Weekend is August 7th-9th. Save Money

During the Missouri's Sales Tax Holiday on things such as:  
Back to school shopping, ie; supplies...

Section 144.049, RSMO, establishes a sales tax holiday during a three-day period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first Friday in August and ending at midnight on the Sunday following. Certain back-to-school purchases, such as clothing, school supplies, computers, and other items as defined by the statute, are exempt from sales tax for this time period only.

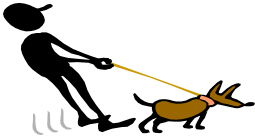

The 39th street city bus will no longer have a 39th Topping stop. The furthest it will come will be 39th & Vanbrunt.

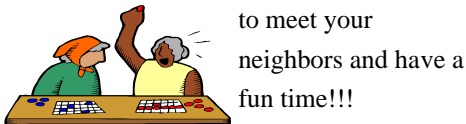
Remember having a pet at River park is not a "right" but a privilege.
