

July 20: Big Time Grain Company and Spider-Man: Homecoming


July 27: County Road 5 and Miracle

Monthly Maintenance

Here are some monthly jobs that should be done to keep appliances and mechanical parts working properly. Doing so will likely extend the life and performance of each item.

- Clean frost-free refrigerator drain pan.
- Grind ice cubes in garbage disposal.
- Maintain drains with baking soda or hot water. Not with chemical drain openers.

Maintenance Moment

Keep cool without shooting your electricity bill sky high: Use fans to circulate air through your home. This keeps rooms cooler longer and reduces the time you're A/C runs.
