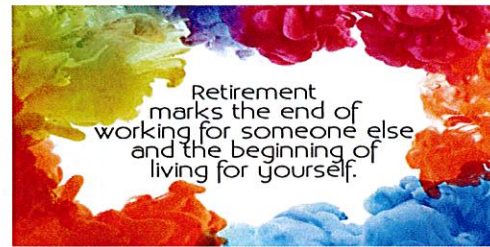


River Park's Annual Yard Sale is coming in August...

A/C Not keeping you Cool

- With summer upon us, the Maintenance Dept. asks that all the members watch the hose at the bottom of their furnace/air conditioner. Water should be dripping out of the end of the hose if your A/C is operating. If you observe that there is no water dripping from the hose, turn off your A/C and call in a work order right away.
- Air flow is necessary for your Furnace/Air Conditioner to operate efficiently. Make sure there is an open space (suggest 4 feet) around your furnace and that your filter is changed in a timely manner.
- If you observe your outside unit is frozen and your A/C is blowing warm air, call in a work order and turn off the A/C so it will thaw and work can be done on it.
- Always keep a path open to the Electrical Box and the Water Shut Off in your basement.

How to make Red White and Blue Deviled Eggs

INGREDIENTS

- 1 dozen hard boiled eggs
- ¼ cup non fat plain yogurt (or desired amount)
- 1 tablespoon mayonnaise (I prefer Hellman's)
- ½ teaspoon dry mustard
- Salt & pepper

INSTRUCTIONS

- Cut eggs in half and take out yolks and place them in a medium bowl.
- Use a pastry cutter or fork to break up yolk until it's super fine.
- Add yogurt, mayo, mustard, salt & pepper and whip up with spatula until smooth and creamy.
- Place mixture into piping bag fitted with a 2D tip.
- Mix 1 cup hot water and 1 teaspoon Americolor food coloring and 1 teaspoon vinegar. The vinegar helps the color stay bright, the vinegar give the eggs a brighter color.
- Place egg whites into the colored water and let sit until desired color is achieved about 1-2 minutes.
- Take out egg whites and place on paper towel to allow excess color to drip off.
- Then arrange eggs on platter.
- Pipe the egg yolk mixture into the egg white halves.
